- A021: Create a Care of Creation Loan Program for Episcopal Dioceses: help dioceses and congregations implement carbon-neutral policies
- A037: Accepting the agreement "Sharing the Gifts of Communion" between The Episcopal Church and the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bavaria: inaugurating full communion
- A045: Celebrate and Support the planting of New Episcopal Worshiping

 Communities: funds to plant new missions and train their leaders
- **A046: Support Starting New Bi-Cultural and Multi-Cultural Ministries:** funds to launch these ministries and train their leaders
- A110: Clarify Distinction Between Biblical and Modern Israel
- A114: Authorize for use Expansive Language Versions of Eucharistic

 Prayer C: trial use of alternative form of "Star Wars" prayer
- A115: Authorized use of alternative texts for the Good Friday Liturgy: alternative Epistle and amended Passion Gospel of John
- A116: Marriage Rites for Inclusion in the Book of Common Prayer (First Reading): authorize trial use of these alternative rites
- A135: Compensation for Non-Stipendiary Clergy: Encourage each diocese to consider paying unpaid clergy a minimum of \$25 a month to give them access to the Church Pension Fund

- A160: Revise Catechism in the Book of Common Prayer: amend definition of Holy Matrimony from between "one man and one woman" to "two persons"
- A165: The Confirmation of the Presiding Bishop Elect: Election of the Rt. Rev. Sean Rowe as Presiding Bishop and Primate of The Episcopal Church
- C011: Add Howard W. Thurman to The Episcopal Church Calendar: An omnibus resolution including initial steps to add Ilia Chavchavadze of Georgia to the Church Calendar, a Convocation resolution originally proposed by St. Nino's Mission, Tbilisi; and of Howard W. Thurman.
- C023: Commemorating The Philadelphia Eleven in the Church
 Calendar: An omnibus resolution including trial addition to the
 Church Calendar of Elie Naud (a Convocation resolution), minister
 to African-American slaves in New York, and trial addition of
 commemoration of the ordination of the first women priests in The
 Episcopal Church
- **C002: On Responsible Travel to the Holy Land:** encourage pilgrimages to connect and work with Palestinian Christians
- **C031: Migration with Dignity**: supports universal right of movement and rights to basic quality of life and basic services
- **D006: Rejecting the Theology and Politics of Christian Zionism:** Affirm solidarity with Palestinian Christians and reject the theology and politics of Christian Zionism
- **D007: Peace through Equal Rights in Israel/Palestine**
- D009: Swords into Plowshares: U.S. Accountability and Responsibility in Rebuilding Gaza: Call for US and international contribution to rebuilding of Gaza
- **D012:** Conditioning U.S. Military Assistance to Israel on Human Rights and a Negotiated Peace

D013: Affirm the Imperative of a Palestinian State

D016: Continued Funding of The Beloved Community

D019: Justice and Peace in Ukraine: condemns war crimes and targeting of civilians

D032: Raising the Clergy Mandatory Retirement Age to 75: study feasibility of increasing current retirement age of 72 for priests and deacons

D037: Encourage All Ministries of The Episcopal Church to Assess
Intersections with Migration: encourages dioceses and
congregations to study and report on how their ministries connect
with migrants and refugees

D041: Support the Adoption of an Ecumenical Feast Day of Creation in our Liturgical Calendar: Encourage celebration of the first Sunday in September as a day of prayer for Creation, and a Season of Creation from September 1 to October 4

D056: Calling for Ceasefire in Gaza

D060: Support for a Solution to the Crisis in Haiti

D062: Support and Solidarity with Armenia

D070: Prayers for Haiti: Encourage congregations to pray regularly for the people of Haiti

D075: The Immediate Release of Ms. Layan Nasir, 24, from
Administrative Detention in Israel, a Palestinian Anglican taken from her family home in the occupied West Bank city of Birzeit
